“Harm Reduction”, which ignores prevention, has been the basis for national drug policy for 16 years. It was designed to destroy, not save lives. It encourages substance use by legalizing drugs, then offers treatment for the victims. Then, in spite of the undeniable link between drugs and crime, criminals are not prosecuted. The results have been catastrophic. America is now a narco-nation, no longer safe in most places.

Roughly 679 people die every day from drugs; 300 from drug overdoseⁱ, 133 homicidesⁱⁱ, 135 suicidesⁱⁱⁱ, and 106 traffic deaths due to marijuana and other drugs^{iv}. Add deaths from cancer, cardiac arrest, strokes and other health causes, and the figure is easily 1,000 a day. The economic cost is estimated at **\$3.73 trillion^v**. Nothing in modern history compares with the lives destroyed, or lost.

We have a national crisis of **mental health, addiction, record levels of suicide, a continually growing homeless population. Mass shootings and homicides are a daily occurrence, almost always caused by marijuana induced psychosis.** Crime of all natures is rampant and getting worse. We have an invasion of foreign cartels growing marijuana, causing irreparable harm to the environment and wildlife, Then selling toxin laden products throughout the US. **America has been betrayed by those elected to protect them, owing primarily to one man: Soros.**

SCIENTIFIC FACTS AND SOCIETAL IMPACTS

Marijuana is a danger to those who use it, and in turn they are a danger to others. Harms discovered 50 years ago when the THC content was only 2% revealed **significant changes to the brain**, especially during adolescence. That included **shrinkage of the hippocampus, the learning, memory and cognition center of the brain**, and **loss of white matter by as much as 80%**; measurable increase in risk of **schizophrenia**; increased risk of **psychotic symptoms**; elevated risk of **suicidal thoughts**; **more DNA damage than even heroin causing physical and mental abnormalities to a fetus**. Still births rose from 12 normal to 44%.

In 2024 the harms are worse. THC content in smoked form is often 20 to 25%, and as high as 99% as waxes, condensates and oils used in dabbing, vaping and edibles. **ER visits are up** significantly for all age groups. **Vaping is causing lung damage** and death. Roughly 15% of users are genetically susceptible to delusions and psychotic reactions leading to **suicides, homicides. Marijuana induced psychosis is a factor in almost all mass murders**, which are now occurring 1.4 times a day. **Marijuana is a cause of autism, which now affects 1 in 36 babies.** Roughly **1 in 5 or 6 drivers are impaired** to some degree, posing a threat to everyone. The enlarged marijuana market created a vast new market for other drugs, **including fentanyl.**

Marijuana Induced Psychosis

Cause of All Mass Murders

Marijuana-induced-psychosis is the cause of almost all mass murders, now happening 1.4 times a day. Two notable examples follow:



Uvalde, Texas | Salvador Ramos | 18 years old

He shot his grandmother in the face when she wouldn't let him smoke pot, then went and **killed 17 children and 2 teachers.**



Parkland, Florida | Nikolas Cruz | 25 years old

He killed 17 and wounded 17 in Parkland, Florida. He admitted using "a lot" of marijuana resulting in voices telling him to kill and attempt suicide multiple times.

Homicides Caused by Psychotic Breaks

Some people detach from reality and experience extreme paranoia. There are numerous cases of dismembering friends and family members, and suicides.



Thousand Oaks, California

Bryn Speicher | 32 years old

Bryn took 2 hits on a bong, then stabbed her boyfriend 108 times, killed her dog and tried to slash her own throat. She was sentenced to 300 hours community service.



Edmonton, Canada

Adam Kehl | 30 years old

Adam stabbed and decapitated his own beloved father, throwing his head in the lake. He served 5 years in prison.

Marijuana - A Major Cause of Traffic Deaths

All users don't experience psychosis, but all users are mentally impaired because THC stays in the brain for a month, compounding with additional use. People aren't even safe on the sidewalk.



Changes Needed To Protect Our Youth And Nation

*“Harm Reduction” has destroyed more lives, killed more people, destroyed more communities, caused more environmental harm and inflict more economic cost on America than all external enemies combined. Good drug policy includes **Supply, Treatment/Rehabilitation, and Prevention.** Even Soros states “... **Prevention is the single most important dimension of the responsibility to protect ...**” in his book, *The Bubble of American Supremacy.* The question is why doesn't he promote it?*

Prevention Is the Basis for Sound Drug Policy

We must start with an **educational campaign** to dispel the myth that marijuana is harmless. There should be a **uniform nationwide prevention program for schools/parents with age-appropriate education and best practices, and include drug testing as a deterrent.**

The program should be designed by a non-governmental coalition of experts working with SAMHSA, to be implemented and paid out of existing grant funds which flow to all states. Strengthen **federal and state laws to discourage possession and drug use**, rather than encourage it as is the case with “Harm Reduction.” Federal funds flowing to States and institutions must serve as an incentive for compliance.

National Leadership

A well-qualified cabinet level Drug Czar should be appointed and supported by the Administration to guide and enforce sound drug policies for supply, treatment and prevention.

Transparency

The perception of harm of marijuana is low owing to suppression of the facts for 16 years. So that people and politicians are aware, In every case of a mass murder, homicides, suicides and traffic death, the **toxicology report and results of a hair- test of the killer must be made available.**

Stop the Invasion of Foreign Cartels

Federal law already allows confiscation of properties used to grow or sell illicit drugs. This could be coupled with fines and imprisonment. Funds and support should be extended from the Federal government to States for implementation, drawing on the National Guard as required.

Government Must Protect the People

Federal drug policy must focus first and foremost on Preventing drug use, but include interdicting Supply and Treatment. It must be consistent from one Administration to the next, enforced and free of the corruptive influence of billionaires and drug dealers who have no concern for human life.
