Subject: National Drug Policy Is Destroying America

Dear President Trump:

This nation needs your help and leadership to address the national drug crisis, which is killing more people, destroying more lives, and costing more money than any war in American history. You have done a remarkable job in a short amount of time creating a great cabinet. But it is time to address the drug problem.

For the record, my colleagues and I have been engaged in drug prevention at the local, state, and national level for 3 and 4 decades. In retrospect, the thousands and thousands of hours I and others have spent trying to get kids safely to adulthood have been wasted because of flawed drug policies at the federal level. While I am not authorized to speak for others, I can speak for myself in saying I feel we have all been betrayed. The primary responsibility to protect the public lies with the federal government. Our efforts should have been in support, not a reaction to failed policy at the federal level. That must change with this Administration, or the Republic will never recover.

SUBJECT I: GEORGE AND ALEXANDER SOROS – ORCHESTRATING AMERICA'S DEMISE

For the better part of the past 37 years, and the last 16 in particular, drug policy has been dictated by George Soros, with intent to change and destroy America. He has now endowed his son Alexander and the Open Society Foundation with \$25 billion to carry on his journey to destroy American values and supremacy. He is guilty of sedition on many fronts, including BLM, Defund the Police, Open Borders, financing Antifa, financing DA's that won't prosecute crime, controlling the media, financing Wokeism at elementary schools, and financing state legalization of marijuana and other drugs with no regard for human life.

Since the Obama/Holder regime, National Drug Policy has been “Harm Reduction,” a deceptive term for misery and death. The concept was created by Ethan Nadelmann, an intellectually arrogant former Princeton professor whose mission was to legalize all drugs, then funded and made famous by George Soros. The concept was initiated in Australia in 1993/4 as a model to be replicated in the U.S. The results were catastrophic in terms of creating mental illness, addiction, crime, destroyed families and death. In 1996, Nadelmann spearheaded Prop 215 to legalize “medical” marijuana in California, funded by Soros and friends. In 1998, he and Soros created the Drug Policy Alliance (DPA) to further advocate for “Harm Reduction”, despite its deplorable history. From 2009 it has become national drug policy only because of Soros’ control of the Democratic Party.

By design, “Harm Reduction” avoids PREVENTION of drug use altogether. It promotes LEGALIZING possession and use of all drugs, and not punishing crime because addicts “.....*have a health problem.*” The net effect is for the last 16 years in particular, literally millions of Americans have lost their lives, or had their lives destroyed, and retail crime has grown nationwide. Since 2009, the federal government has also abdicated its responsibility to enforce federal CSU laws. Roughly 40 States have legalized marijuana for medicinal or recreational use. At last count, 445,000 people now market this federally banned illegal drug that causes mental illness, addiction, psychosis leading to school shootings, mass murders, suicides, traffic fatalities, and DNA damage which cause physical and mental abnormalities not only in a fetus, but all in their future line of children and grandchildren. The less observable harms caused by marijuana and other drugs to a fetus include autism, ADHD, Atrial Septal Defect (ASD), physical deformities, and still births. Marijuana is rightly categorized as an attack on humanity itself.

Action Required:

1 George Soros and Ehtan Nadelmann should be held accountable as domestic terrorists. Their writings alone are sufficient to establish their intent and willful contributions to legalize “medical” and recreational marijuana which have and continue to cause death and destruction to millions of Americans.

2. Any further influence by Alexander Soros on the leadership of the Democratic Party must be stopped. Consideration should be given to confiscating the assets of the Open Society Foundation (OSF) to cover even a miniscule amount of the damage they have inflicted on this nation.

3. The Drug Policy Alliance (DPA) should be shut down and held accountable for numerous deaths. In 2021 they spearheaded Prop 110 in Oregon calling for legalization of all drugs. Financing was provided by George Soros, Mark Zuckerberg, and John London to the tune of about \$5 million. After 3 years the bill was repealed after the overdose death rate rose from 182 in 2021 to a staggering 1,363 in 2024 (CDC.gov), number 1 in the country.

SUBJECT II. LEGALIZATION OF MARIJUANA IS A FAILED POLICY THAT MUST BE REVERSED.

Legalization has created an invasion of foreign cartels and a vast new Black market that dwarfs the legal market. These people are destroying the planet, trafficking humans, eradicating wildlife, and then marketing marijuana products throughout the US and beyond that are laden with toxins, even human waste. America has essentially become a narco-nation, not safe for anyone.

We need your help to make America safe again. I believe the following job descriptions for the DOJ and DEA suggest a path forward:

U.S. Department of Justice – The mission of the U.S. Department of Justice is to **enforce the law** and defend the interests of the United States according to the law; **to ensure public safety against threats foreign and domestic; to provide federal leadership in preventing and controlling crime; to seek just punishment for those guilty of unlawful behavior;** and to ensure fair and impartial administration of justice for all Americans.

- **Drug Enforcement Administration** — The mission of the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) is **to enforce the controlled substances laws and regulations of the United States** and bring to the criminal and civil justice system of the United States, or any other competent jurisdiction, **those organizations and principal members of organizations, involved in the growing, manufacture, or distribution of controlled substances appearing in or destined for illicit traffic** in the United States; and **to recommend and support non-enforcement programs aimed at reducing the availability of illicit controlled substances on the domestic and international markets.**

The Biden Administration essentially destroyed what was left of ONDCP. For 16 years there has been no effort to enlighten the American public on the harms of marijuana. In the same time frame the potency has elevated from about 5% to as high as 99%. The market has increased from about 16 million to 55 million which created a vast new market for opioids and fentanyl. The overdose rate has increased from about 105 a day to the unthinkable level of 300 a day. Add other deaths from shootings, homicides, suicides, traffic deaths and health related deaths, and the total is easily 1,000 people a day.

The DEA and ONDCP are essentially on parallel paths in many ways and perhaps should be merged. The Homeland Security issue is a greater threat and more damaging at the moment than our foreign adversaries. Perhaps the DEA and ONDCP should move under the Department of Defense, especially if that would stabilize drug policies from Administration to Administration, and eliminate the impact of special interests like Soros and those who choose to profit from the sale of illicit drugs, with no concern for human lives.

The nation needs a strong, Cabinet-level Drug Czar, fully supported by the Commander-In-Chief, to include a robust Awareness and Prevention program, in addition to efforts to interdict Supply and provide treatment for addicts. We will never totally win the War-On-Drugs. But a Parents enlightenment program like the one in the Reagan era reduced drug use by 63%. That would be a good place to begin. Reducing the Demand for drugs will obviously reduce the need for Supply and Prevention/Treatment as well.

Aside from Prevention, enforcing federal laws again is vital. Since Eric Holder, and the Cole memo, **the federal government has abdicated its responsibility to enforce federal law.** States and local law enforcement have been given the task, **without the resources to perform,** while the majority are enamored with the tax revenues from legalizing marijuana. In California, Siskiyou and Shasta Counties illustrate the problem. One sheriff and two deputies have to contend with 5 to 8,000 illegal marijuana grows, many controlled by Hmong. When the County took legal action to shut them down, the Hmong counter sued for discrimination and the County had to settle by paying their legal fees of close to \$200,000. Speaking for all of us in California and the nation,

protecting public safety and enforcing federal laws belongs to the Federal Government. A strong national defense against internal enemies is as important as defending against foreign adversaries. Probably more so given the level of death, destruction, and economic cost. Consideration should be given to:

- 1) **Instructing all US Attorneys to seize properties that are growing and/or illegally marketing marijuana and other drugs.** The properties could be given to local governments to sell or for environmental reclamation, if that is even possible. If the operators are illegals they should be deported.
- 2) **An Executive order should be issued by the President to immediately provide results from toxicology reports and a hair sample to the public and politicians in the case of all school or mass shootings, homicides, traffic deaths, and suicides.**

People and politicians need to know the real cause is not the weapon, but the shooter. A hair sample gives a 90-day window of detection for all drugs. In the vast majority of cases, marijuana induced psychosis is a factor.

The Soros inspired move to reschedule marijuana introduced by Biden should be scrapped if it hasn't already. The DEA is well informed after 5 or 6 decades of studies by the FDA and others that rightly categorize marijuana as a Schedule 1 drug. Speaking on behalf of thousands who have spent 3 and 4 decades fighting to keep kids safe and drug free, many of us who have lost kids to death or addiction would welcome a return to a strong DEA and ONDCP, fully supported by a new Administration. I think I can speak for all of us on the front lines saying we are eager and willing to share our experience to help.

Subject III: AN EDUCATIONAL SEMINAR IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR THE PRESIDENT, VP, AND ALL MEMBERS OF THE CABINET PRESENTED BY THE BEST EXPERTS ON THE SCIENTIFIC FACTS OF MARIJUANA AND THE DEVASTATING IMPACTS OF LEGALIZATION.

For 16 years the true harms of marijuana have been suppressed, to the extent the vast majority of Americans, including politicians, have no understanding of the devastating impacts on humans and public safety. While the fentanyl crisis is real, and measures to stop the supply are valid, but reducing the Demand is equally as important. The reality is that the vast majority of those who use fentanyl started their drug journey with marijuana. PREVENTION is still THE most important component of good drug policy. America can never be great again until it is SAFE again, and it cannot be safe until a sound, lasting drug policy **is implemented by the Commander-in-Chief**. A top-down approach is needed, and all of the superb cabinet members must be fully enlightened as the national drug crisis impacts all else that they hope to accomplish. An Awareness program must be initiated as well for all governors and state and local politicians, most of whom only receive guidance from paid lobbyist from the drug trade.

An outline on Marijuana Facts is included in your brochure, as well as a Test to ensure every participant understands the basics. We envision this could be used as a criteria for admission in colleges and universities where statistically 44% of those 19-22 are using marijuana oblivious to the impacts of their ability to learn and retain information, elevated risk of schizophrenia, suicidal ideation, and adverse impacts on their reproductive organs and threat to cause permanent harm to a fetus, and all in their successive line of children and grandchildren.

- 1) **We can arrange for the best experts on drugs and prevention if the President and cabinet will allow a time and place for a 1 ½ to 2 hour meeting in Washington D.C. or potentially Mar A Lago.**
- 2) **An awareness program on the harms of marijuana is essential for the Nation. SAMHSA already has a \$2 billion budget given to all States, 20% of which is to be used for prevention. That could be a start, albeit more is needed to cover all middle, junior, and high schools in the nation. Educating parents is key to prevention, backed by teachers who provide the safety net.**

The expense should be looked at not as an expense, but as an investment that will save lives, save money and help America's youth make America a safe and strong nation.
